You will need a valid current ISI membership. Please renew at www.skateisi.org. Annual cost is \$13.00. The ISI is in the process of transitioning to a uniform annual membership renewal date. Please ensure you are a current member to avoid any disqualifications at ISI endorsed competitions. Skaters must also be regular or associate members of Parade FSC (\$55.00 annual synchro membership fee--this membership level also allows skaters to contract or buy on at member rates on to the PFSC contract ice sessions on Wed & Thursdays at 5:30pm & 6:45 pm and on Saturday at 9:30 am). (Note: if you also wish to skate on the SQSA contract ice sessions you will need to upgrade your membership to the joint SQSA PFSC membership level). Skaters who don't have one also should purchase the official SQSA PARADE warm up jacket at an approximate cost for 2008-2009 of \$95.00-\$120.00 (depending on size). We expect all skaters to use the team jacket at practices at the competitions we enter including when watching other events. Warm up jacket order forms for 2008-2009 will be available by mid August.

Balance of the Basic Contract will be payable in monthly installments of \$95.00. **Attached is a coupon sheet for you to use.** Additional charges that will be added to periodic billing statements and which are NOT reflected in the monthly coupon amount will include: a) Competition entry fees for local Synchro competition events (typically \$12-16 per skater for first event of each competition entered and \$6-10 per skater for second event at the same competition. Please note that for the national synchronized champs the entry fees per skater last year were 20.00 for first event and 15.00 for second events. We would expect the 2009 ISI Synchro Champ-Chicago entry fees to be in this range. The actual competitions to be

entered and number of events entered per competition will be decided by the coach as training evolves during the season-the team may enter as many as 4 in town competitions, plus the New Ulm MN competition plus the Chicago Synchro Champs competition during the 2008-2009 competitive year. b) share of coach's travel expenses for out of town competitions (transportation, lodging meals), c) competition coaching expenses which will be approximately \$5.00 per skater per event competed in d) Share of any practice ice that may be purchased at out of town competitions (a possibility at the ISI Synchro Champs in Chicago) d) Any miscellaneous expenses that may be communicated by the coach from time to time such as a group order for tights, or make-up, or hair nets, etc.

Note: Travel expenses including hotels, meals and transportation for skaters attending out of town competitions will be directly covered by parent(s)/guardian(s). If the decision is made to compete at the ISI Synchro Champs in Chicago in mid April 2009, we may look into costs of chartering a bus for skaters and parents and set up a parent chaperone system for parents who cannot attend. The New Ulm MN Fall Classic competition, which is about 100 miles from Minneapolis/St Paul, generally takes place the weekend before Thanksgiving (official date in 2008 is subject to confirmation but it is expected to be on Nov 22, 2008). It usually involves one overnight stay at a local New Ulm hotel. Parents may work out car pool arrangements. Skaters will be responsible for their skates including getting them re-sharpened as needed.

Please cut out the coupons on the next page and please send them in by the due date with the payment specified. Additional charges for additional expenses that are likely to be incurred, as summarized above, will be reflected in periodic billings that will be issued as these expenses are incurred. Billing statements will include a 'Supplemental Charges Coupon' and will reflect payments you make using the coupons and will remind you of any past due monthly coupons. Skaters who are not current may not be permitted to skate in competitions or in the annual ice show at Parade.
