## POLARETTES Notes:

**Note: Total POLARETTES Dress Cost is estimated at approx \$150.00-170.00. Balance of dress cost, if applicable, after deposit of \$150.00 will be payable upon delivery of the finished dresses in late October.**

You will need a valid current ISI membership. Please renew at [www.skateisi.org](http://www.skateisi.org). Annual cost is \$13.00. Please ensure you are a current member to avoid any disqualifications at ISI endorsed competitions. Skaters must also be regular or associate members of Parade FSC (\$55.00 annual synchro membership fee--this membership level also allows skaters to contract or buy on at member rates on to the PFSC contract ice sessions on Wed & Thursdays at 5:30pm & 6:45 pm and on Saturday at 9:30 am). (Note: if you also wish to skate on the SQSA contract ice sessions you will need to upgrade your membership to the joint SQSA PFSC membership level). Skaters who don't have one also should purchase the official SQSA PARADE warm up jacket at an approximate cost for 2009-2010 of \$95.00-\$120.00 (depending on size). We expect all skaters to use the team jacket at practices at the competitions we enter including when watching other events. Warm up jacket order forms for 2009-2010 will be available by mid August.

Balance of the Basic Contract will be payable in SEVEN monthly installments of \$150.00. **Attached is a coupon sheet for you to use.** Unlike previous years, this year we have included everything in the contract cost including all Competition Entry Fees & Competition Coaching expenses. Also if we do have 11 or more skaters on the line we will be able to recalculate the charge per skater and issue a credit to each skater and reduce the monthly installment.

Special Note for POLARETTES: The POLARETTES plan on competing at one out of town competition in New Ulm, MN. The New Ulm MN Fall Classic competition, which is about 100 miles from Minneapolis/St Paul, generally takes place the weekend before Thanksgiving (official date in 2009 is subject to confirmation but it is expected to be on Nov 21, 2009). Depending on the actual event time, it may involve one overnight stay at a local New Ulm hotel. Travel expenses including hotel, meals and transportation for skaters attending out of town competitions will be directly covered by parent(s)/guardian(s). Parents may work out car pool arrangements and room sharing expenses. The above contract amount assumes that the POLARETTES will compete in New Ulm. If they do not, a credit will be issued to each skaters account equivalent to the entry fees and the coaching expenses including coaches travel that have been factored into this year's budget.

Skaters will be responsible for their skates including getting them re-sharpened as needed.

Please cut out the coupons on the next page and please send them in by the due date with the payment specified. Skaters who are not current may not be permitted to skate in competitions or in the annual ice show at Parade.
